## SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

### **GROSBERG FAMILY JUDAIC STUDIES/HEBREW EDUCATORS' AWARD**

**Deadline – February 28**

**\$5,000 per year awarded to one person\***

This award is given annually to a Judaic Studies/Hebrew educator for study that leads to enhancing the Judaic Studies/Hebrew curriculum of the educational institution or the instructional/administrative practice of the applicant for the benefit of the Jewish community of Winnipeg.

To be eligible for the Grosberg Family Award, an applicant:

- Must be a Judaic Studies/Hebrew educator at an approved and recognized educational institution in Winnipeg
- Must have a recognized, Canadian undergraduate degree and be pursuing studies in a post-graduate program or recognized and approved program that leads to enhancing the Judaic Studies/Hebrew curriculum of the institution or the instructional or administrative practice of the applicant
- Must continue to be an educator (instructor or administrator) in Judaic Studies/Hebrew at his/her educational institution during the course of study and for a period of two years after receipt of the award

Assuming the applicant meets the eligibility requirements set forth above, the following criteria will be used by the selection committee in awarding the scholarship:

- Volunteer Work in the Jewish community of Winnipeg
  - Volunteer Work in the local community of Winnipeg
  - Value to the applicant and student body
  - Financial need
